What is Live Local Longer?

Live Local Longer is brought to the Williams Community by the Williams Community Resource Centre who have collaborated with InCasa Country and Mable Support Services. Together we are able to bring in home aged care to Williams and surrounding areas, allowing people to remain in our community and in their own home longer.

It is a model that draws on 'locals supporting locals' through coordination from a local group and oversight of an approved aged care provider.

To enable the services required by older residents in our region, we are looking for people who have skills and experience in a variety of work, industries and interests.

Through the online platform Mable (www.mable.com.au), you can sign up as an independent support worker and match with clients who are in need of the services you are able to provide.

Examples of services includes but is not limited to Personal Care, Transport Services, Domestic Assistance, Social Support, Meal Assistance, Nursing Services and Home Maintenance Services.







How it works

- Work as a sole trader, embracing the flexibility of being your own boss.
- Choose who you work with, when and the rates you charge.
- Make meaningful connections, allowing you to deliver the best support possible.
- Have insurance provided for including public liability, personal accident and professional indemnity.
- Gain access to free education with opportunities to participate in accredited training.
- Earn more per hour through the on line platform, with Mable contractors receiving the agreed rate, less 10%.

More things to know

- 1. You will need an ABN to sign up as a Mable worker. This is a simple online process through www.abr.gov.au
- 2. Many different skills can be used through this program such as:
- house cleaning
- gardening
- home maintenance
- shopping assistance
- meal preparation
- social outings
- transport to/from appointments

What is mable?

Mable is an online platform that directly connects seniors with independent support workers.

It is the place where you find jobs posted, offer your services, create agreements with clients, submit timesheets and coordinates weekly payments.

- 2. To get started head to www.mable.com.au to set up your online account. Please note you will need the following:
 - a. An ABN
 - b. Two personal or professional references
 - c. National Police Check through Mabel (speak to WCRC to get free code)
 - d. Various forms of ID
- 3. Once your account is active, you will be able to access the jobs board, where you can select which ones interest you.
- 4. You set your own rates, and available times. Payments are made weekly once you submit your timesheets
